Backpacking Trip – Cheaha Wilderness Area: April 18 – 19, 2020

WHAT:	Backpacking Trip ~5.5 miles in from the Cheaha Trailhead, camp at Odum/Chinnabee/Pinhoti trail crossing, then ~4.7 miles out to High Falls Trail Head
WHERE:	IN: Cheaha Trailhead on AL-281, Delta, AL 36258; OUT: High Falls Trail Head on High Falls Trail, Lineville, AL 36266
LEAVE:	8:00 a.m. Saturday, April 18 from the Scout Hut parking lot.
RETURN:	Sunday, April 19 about 4:00 p.m. to the Scout Hut parking lot.
FOOD:	BRING bag lunch for Saturday. PLAN dinner on Saturday plus breakfast on Sunday, to be cooked by patrols. Bring food you were assigned by your Patrol. Bring money for lunch on the way home.
NOTES:	MUST have (or borrow) a back pack and appropriate sleeping bag. Will need to have or buddy with someone with a backpacking tent. Watch weather and adjust gear accordingly!
