**WARNING:**

Under Georgia law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Chapter 12 of Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.

Without limiting the statutory protections offered under the above-referenced Georgia law, each of the undersigned for an on behalf of himself or herself and those for whom he or she has parental or guardianship rights or responsibilities, does hereby, now and forever, unconditionally and irrevocably, release, acquit and discharge Trackrock and its owners, directors, officers, employees and agents, and the real property on which it conducts equine activities and the owners thereof (collectively “Trackrock”) from any and all past, present and future claims of any kind or character, and any and all liabilities now accrued or hereafter to accrue, which the undersigned may have, claim to have or may hereafter have or claim to have, against Trackrock on account of or because of, any and all damages, claims, losses, demands, bodily or personal injuries, death, causes of action, or liabilities of any nature whatsoever, in law or in equity, whether known or not known, developed or undeveloped, resulting or to result by reasons of, arising out of, or relating to, the undersigned’s (including those for whom he or she has parental or guardianship rights or responsibilities) participation in the equine activities offered by Trackrock.

**PARTICIPANT’S RELEASE OF LIABILITY – PAGE TWO**

**NATURE OF HORSES** – I/We understand that Trackrock Stables chooses its rental horses for their calm dispositions and sound basic training as is required for use as riding horses for novice and beginning riders. If a horse is frightened or provoked it may divert from its training and act according to its natural survival instincts which may include, but are not limited to, stopping short, changing directions or speed at will, bucking, rearing, kicking, biting or running from danger.

**CONDITIONS OF NATURE** – Trackrock Stables is not responsible for acts and occurrences, or elements of nature that can scare a horse, cause it to fall, or react in some other unsafe way. Such conditions include thunder, lightening, rain, wind, water, wild and domestic animals, insects, reptiles, which may walk, run or fly near, or bit or sting a horse or person; and irregular footing on out of door groomed or wild land which is subject to constant change in condition according to weather, temperature, and natural and man-made changes in landscape.

**RIDER RESPONSIBILITY** – The rider shall be responsible for his/her own safety. Riders should not carry loose items on rides which may fall, blow away, lap in the wind, bounce, or make sharp noises, possibly scaring a horse. Such items include cameras, video cameras, hats, purses or packs. Riders must not make sharp, loud noises such as screaming or yelling, which may scare a horse. The riders shall also be responsible for the safety of any unborn child if the rider is pregnant. **Trackrock Stables advises pregnant women not to ride horses**, unless permission is given under advice of her physician.

**PHOTO RELEASE** - For good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I hereby authorize Trackrock Riding Academy, Inc. d/b/a Trackrock Stables (“Trackrock”) permission to use my likeness in a photograph in any and all of its publications, including but not limited to all Trackrock’s printed and digital publications.
